exceedances. On April 13, 2020, AQD received the results of the new test which was conducted on April 9, 2020. The results showed an H₂S concentration of 25,000 ppmv.

Please submit a written and electronic response to this Violation Notice by May 5, 2020 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
