

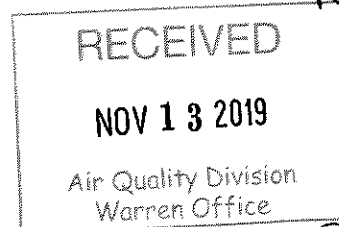

In regards to your site visit on October 11, 2019, where you observed fugitive dust leaving our site, we have taken the following actions:

- We have made sure that the areas where the fugitive dust was forming have been watered down, either by mother nature or by our onsite water truck. We have increased the frequency of watering with our water truck.
- Upper management has been making frequent tours around the yard to make sure that the areas are being thoroughly and frequently watered. Held truck traffic to specific speed limits in order to reduce the amount of dust they put into the air.
- We currently have a contract with a sweeping company to clean our site weekly. We also have the sweeping company on call, to come sweep more frequently based upon weather.
- We have reshaped our material piles to decrease the amount of dust that can be blown off of them.

In addition to the steps we have taken, we are currently discussing long term solutions to further reduce the possibilities of fugitive dust leaving our site. Such as a possible construction of a berm in the north east corner of our property, with vegetation covering it, to act as a natural wind break between our property and our neighbors.
