This is Lyle Hippensteel/Mt Crushmor responding to your notice of Violation RE: Dust control.

I am working on several fronts in an effort to resolve issues with regard to providing dust control measure when production procedures produce dust opacity, in excess of allowances as outlined by DEQ.

I have obtained an underground fuel storage that I am trying to equip as a water source for the water spraying equipment that is installed on the jaw crusher, as well as for the to be installed, spray system on the Fintec 542 Screener.

I am having difficulty obtaining a water source at the present time, since I am located at the rear portion of a 24 acre site. The City of Flint has a moratorium on well drilling for any new wells and the cost to purchase water from the City public water system would be prohibitive.

As work progresses towards this end, we are trying our best to only run material that has been dampened by rain or freshly removed from the ground with a contact of dirt that provides a shield from excessive dust emissions.

I will continue to keep you updated as we progress in this endeavor and appreciate your input and patience in this matter.
