

SUBJECT: Violation Notice Response



Dear Ms. Lazzaro –

This email is in response to the Violation Notice you sent to me dated October 21, 2021. The Violation Notice said I was operating my burn-off oven without an air permit. You recommended I contact Jenifer Dixon in your Clean Air Assistance Program to see if she could help me with a permit application. I did that and Ms. Dixon and I have been gathering the information we need to submit a complete application. I have given permission to Ms. Dixon to be able to talk to you about our progress on the permit application. I will submit an application to the EGLE Air Quality Permit Section by December 15, 2021, if not sooner.

Additionally, I have purchased and installed a new afterburner on the oven to reduce any smoke issues. I am continuing to watch my temperatures and emissions closely during any burns I do to make sure my equipment is operating properly and within the temperatures needed to minimize pollutants from my stack. If I see any smoke, I am making the needed adjustments right away.
