VIOLATION NOTICE

Dear Mr. Gingerich:

On January 31, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at the corner of North Delano Road and West Whitman Road, Au Gres, Arenac County, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Mr. Steve Gingerich owns the subject property and performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject property, an old schoolhouse, was found to not have an asbestos survey or a notification prior to demolition. The building structure was demolished and in a pile. Regulated Asbestos Containing Materials were found within the debris. In discussion with Mr. Gingerich, he stated he was not aware of the NESHAP program and its requirements, but that he had spoken with Whitney Township about demolishing the building and thought he had met all requirements needed prior to demolition.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this violation notice by March 2, 2019, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
