Inspection Summary

I entered the visitor entrance area went to the office area. I informed the receptionist of the purpose of my visit and asked if anyone from maintenance or if the maintenance supervisor was available. The receptionist stated that the maintenance supervisor was off site, but could be contacted by phone. She called Mike Loll and allowed me to speak with him. Mike stated that there was not a incinerator installed that he was aware of. I informed him that based on this information I feel comfortable voiding the permit. I informed Mike that I would void the permit associated with the incinerator. No other permits are issued to this site.

This permit is void based on the condition that although the incinerator is still installed, it is inoperable and no longer in use.
