### **VIOLATION NOTICE**

Quality Division (AQD) conducted a complaint investigation at 5203 Morrish Road, Swartz Creek, Genesee County. The purpose of this investigation was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. On December 16, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air

According to my investigation, Mr. Randall is the owner of the former Swartz Creek Elevator and RBF Construction performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the owner and operator liable for all violations.
