## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On August 8, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 222 East High Street, Jackson, Jackson County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, the City of Jackson owns the subject property and Adrian Environmental, LLC, performed the Planned Renovation activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject property had been previously abated of plaster and duct insulation. However, duct insulation was observed on a register boot in the dining room and expansion fabric was noted on the furnace in the basement. The expansion fabric tested 40 percent chrysotile form asbestos. The expansion fabric was not identified in the asbestos report.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by September 9, 2019, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
