RE: VIOLATION NOTICE AT 3323 WEST MICHIGAN AVE., JACKSON

Dear Jeremy Howe:

This letter is in response to the notice I received dated December 21, 2023, regarding violations 40 CFR 61.145 (a) and 40 CFR 61.145 (b)(1) for the demolition site at 3323 West Michigan Ave., Jackson, Michigan.

The demolition began and was completed on December 12, 2023. The failure to submit a finalized asbestos inspection and 10-day demolition notice was due to the fact that the owner (Richard Walicki) and operator (Jimmy Lester) were both of the understanding that the other party had taken care of these notifications. The violations are not ongoing, as the demolition is complete. Both the owner and operator have been notified of this oversight and are in agreement that for *any and all* future demolitions/projects, the responsibility of scheduling an asbestos inspection and providing a 10-day intent to demolish will be **clearly outlined and executed**. This will prevent any future misunderstandings and any reoccurrences of these violations.

The owner and operator both apologize for this oversight. We appreciate all your division does to ensure the safety of our community.

Dear Richard Walicki and Jimmy Lester:

VIOLATION NOTICE

On December 18, 2023, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 3323 West Michigan Avenue, Jackson, Jackson County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my investigation, Jim Winter Automotive Group owns the subject property and Lester Brothers Excavation, Inc. performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject facility had been recently demolished, and the demolition contractor was on-site finishing loadout of the foundation. A notification of intent to demolish had not been submitted and a thorough asbestos inspection had not been performed.



Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this violation notice by January 11, 2024, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
