### **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On July 23, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 3717 Cork Street, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo County, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, ENAS Hospitality owns the subject property and ACE Demolition Inc., performed the abatement and demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject facility was mostly demolished with only a partial wall still standing, the slab foundation was in place along with a debris pile. The Notification's project schedule stated that the demolition's end date was July 12, 2019. Additionally, staff observed and sampled (3717-4) broken and crumbled pieces of board backing. The test results indicated that the board backing contained 20 percent chrysotile form asbestos. The asbestos containing waste was dry and scattered throughout the debris pile.

The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
