VIOLATION NOTICE

Dear Matt Bennett and Aaron Popa:

On October 10, 2023, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 502 West Dresden Street, 106 West Walnut Street, and 131 South Cedar Street, Kalkaska, Kalkaska County, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my investigation, the Village of Kalkaska owns the subject properties and Matt's Underground Utility Construction performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Matt's Underground was in the process of demolition and loading out debris at 131 South Cedar Street, Kalkaska. Matt Bennett stated that an asbestos building survey had been completed and all necessary asbestos abatement was completed prior to demolition. However, the Asbestos NESHAP 10-day notification for demolition was not submitted prior to the start of demolition.

In discussion with Matt Bennett and Aaron Popa, it was discovered that Matt's Underground Utility Construction also demolished structures at 502 West Dresden Street and 106 North Walnut Street, both without submitting the Asbestos NESHAP 10-day notification.

The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
