VIOLATION NOTICE

On November 20, 2018, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) complaint investigation at 100 East Patterson Street, Tecumseh, Lenawee County. The purpose of this investigation was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Great Lakes Aerial Maintenance & Construction Company owns the subject facility and Roe Brothers Bulldozing and Excavating is the contractor who is performing the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Demolition of the former industrial facility was taking place and load-out of demolition debris was occurring. The Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish, which was submitted to the administrator, expired on July 31, 2018. The owner and the contractor had failed to update their notification and/or inform the administrator of the new project schedule's end date. Project scheduling is imperative for regulators to perform a compliance inspection.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by December 17, 2018, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
