VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 6, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 2700 East Grand River Avenue, Howell, Livingston County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Ostlund A Service Company, LLC owns the subject property and has performed the renovation activities as well. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject commercial property was in the process of being renovated. The owner/operator failed to have a thorough asbestos inspection done prior to renovation activities that could disturb asbestos containing materials. Suspect asbestos containing material was observed in the facility and was sampled and tested. The sample test results indicated that asbestos was present in transite wallboard and exterior caulk.

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Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by September 4, 2019, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
