VIOLATION NOTICE

On April 17, 2023, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection at 4227 John Martin Road, Moran, Mackinac County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my investigation, Ben Lowe, owns the facility which was used for the intentional burn and Mackinac County 911 & Emergency Management, performed the intentional burn activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the *owner and/or operator* liable for all violations.

During the inspection, EGLE staff observed the following:

The facility was intentionally burned and only smoldering building debris remained. The Notice of Intent to Renovate/Demolish had a project start date of April 19, 2023, which was 10-working days from the Notice's submission date. The intentional burn, which was performed by the Mackinac County 911 & Emergency Management, occurred prior to the required 10-working day wait period.

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

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by May 10, 2023 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the date(s) the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the date(s) by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. The *signed* written response from the *owner and operator* to this violation notice, may be submitted by mail and directed to my attention at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. You must also include a copy to Jason Wolf, Enforcement Unit at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. The response may be scanned and emailed to DechyC@Michigan.gov and WolfJ2@Michigan.gov.

If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
