VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 13, and August 18, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the former Erin Presbyterian Church, located at 30000 Gratiot Ave., Roseville. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Gratiot STA, LLC's and ZLM Services, LLC's compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, Gratiot STA, LLC owns the facility and ZLM Services, LLC performed the demolition activities at the facility. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, AQD staff observed that the garage and a portion of the church had been demolished; building debris and metals for recycling were still on site. A notification of intent to demolish had not been submitted to the AQD prior to demolition. Sampling identified regulated asbestos containing materials as well as Category I asbestos containing materials at the identified site.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by September 15, 2020 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Gratiot STA, LLC and ZLM Services, LLC believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide factual information to explain your position.
