VIOLATION NOTICE

Street, Midland, Midland County, Michigan. On December 16, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection at 1150 West Wackerley

Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of

Contractors of Pitsch Companies performed the demolition activities at the site. The According to our investigation, Mr. Kern is the owner of the property and Demolition National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the owner and operator liable for all violations.

During the investigation staff observed the following:

The subject structure was in the process of being demolished with asbestos containing material still in place. On December 8, 2021, I conducted an inspection of the site and with the crew from Pitsch and Brian Taylor of SBS, and told them that the debris piles. was also dry and dust from the debris pile was being generated by the wind. I talked water needed to be used on the building, debris, debris piles, and concrete slab in order and concrete slab must be kept wet at ALL times until disposed of in an approved from the demolition that were dry. The main demolition debris pile next to the building to keep it wet and to prevent any visible emissions in order to be in compliance with had a discussion with SBS (the general contractor onsite). It was discussed that more NESHAP. During my inspection on December 16, 2021, I noticed several piles of metal

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this violation notice by January 12, 2022 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the date(s) the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the date(s) by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. The *signed* written response from the *owner and operator* to this violation notice, may be submitted by mail and directed to my attention at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. You must also include a copy to Mr. Jason Wolf, Enforcement Unit at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
