VIOLATION NOTICE

On November 10, 2022, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the two bridges located at I75 and Nadeau Road, Frenchtown Township and I75 and Swan Creek/Newport Road, Berlin Township in Monroe County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) and Walsh Construction Company II, LLC's compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, MDOT owns the bridges and Walsh Construction Company II, LLC demolished both structures. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

On November 10, 2022, AQD staff noted that the bridges had been demolished. According to our investigation, S03 of 58152 (Nadeau Road) was demolished August 12-15, 2022, and S05 of 58152 (Swan Creek/Newport Road) was demolished between November 4-7, 2022. An asbestos survey had been conducted prior to the demolition of each structure. However, the required 10 working day notifications for each structure had not been submitted to EGLE prior to demolition.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by December 27, 2022 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation, whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
