On February 19, 2016, I conducted a level-2 self-initiated inspection of Electro-Matic Products, Inc. ("Electro-Matic" or "EM"), located at 23409 Industrial Park Court, Farmington Hills, MI 48335-2849. The inspection was conducted to determine compliance with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994, PA 451; and Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) administrative rules.

During the FY 2016 inspection, Mr. Steven M. Chase (Phone: 248-722-4502-Derect or 247-478-1182; Fax: NA; E-mail: smChase@Electro-Matic.com), Plant Manager, assisted me.

Electro-Matic Products, Inc. ("Electro-Matic" or "EM") sells electrical and electronic components to GM, Ford, FCA (Chrysler), and automotive suppliers (all Tiers). EM performs predominantly warehousing operations with assembly (if required based upon customer needs) of electrical and electronic components (industrial electronic components predominantly for automotive industry). In one of four buildings, indoor / outdoor LED messages (Factory Vision) are assembled. EM buys and sells automation components to automotive industry. Based upon customer instructions / needs, EM also assembles the components from various manufacturers into one assembled unit and distributes. Warehousing is performed in four buildings in Farmington Hills:

- 1. 23409 Industrial Park Court, Farmington Hills
- 2. 23410 Industrial Park Court, Farmington Hills
- 3. 23412 Industrial Park Court, Farmington Hills
- 4. 23660 Industrial Park Drive, Farmington Hills (LED messages)

In addition, sales offices are located in Grand Rapids (MI) and Akron (OH). Warehousing of automation components is done for various manufacturers.

Frequently, electronic components are assembled in metal boxes. Hence, one Steinhauer Elektromaschinen, AG, machine to cut holes in boxes is present. All exhaust gases are released to in-plant environment. The machine is exempt from Rule 336.1201 (Permit-to-Install) pursuant to Rule 336.285(I).

Conclusion

Metal cutting, warehousing and assembly operations (four buildings) are exempt from Rule 336.1201 (Permit-to-Install) pursuantito, Rule 336.285.
