On Tuesday, July 24, 2019, Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) staff, I, Adam Bognar, conducted a self-initiated inspection of Seamen Manufacturing Company located at 29 West Rundell, Pontiac, MI 48056. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance status with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) rules; and Permit to Install No. 394-73.

I arrived at this location at around 2:30 pm.

According to AQD files, Seaman Manufacturing Company operated an incinerator and two trash compactors with an associated cyclone dust collector at this location in the past. The last records of communication between AQD and the company was in 1974 when Seaman Manufacturing Company obtained Permit to install No. 394-73 for the equipment listed above. Permit to Install No. 394-73 is an active permit.

The building at this address is now occupied by a car and boat storage warehouse. There is one employee working there. I identified myself, provided credentials, and stated the purpose of the inspection. I explained that there is an active air permit associated with the warehouse. The employee allowed me into his storage warehouse. I was able to verify that the equipment associated with Permit to Install No. 394-73 has been removed from the location.

There does not appear to be any AQD regulated equipment in this warehouse. The warehouse is used only for storage.

The AQD Seamen Manufacturing Company file will be archived as a result of this inspection.

Compliance Determination

I was not able to verify compliance with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; and Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) rules.

An email was sent to Sue Thelen on September 17, 2019 requesting to void Permit to Install No. 394-73.
