VIOLATION NOTICE

On January 13, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection at 1258 Rochester Road, Troy, Oakland and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of
