VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 11 and July 6, 2022, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the commercial property located at 228 Walton, Pontiac. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, Coney Café, Inc. owns the facility and Ace Site & Supply LLC performed the demolition activities. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operators equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following: A vacant commercial building damaged by fire. Demolition of the remaining structure was conducted without submission of a10-day notification of intent to renovate/demolish and the slab remains in place. EGLE staff sampled the multi-layer flooring that remains on the slab and several of these layers tested positive for asbestos.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by August 12, 2022 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
