Staff, April Lazzaro arrived at the facility to conduct an unannounced, scheduled inspection and met with Richard Diekema, Maintenance Supervisor. Mr. Diekema was provided with the DEQ Environmental Inspections: Rights and Responsibilities brochure and its contents were discussed.

This facility manufactures commercial vacuum cleaners/scrubbers of various sizes. All painted or injection molded items are done out of house. No painting or solvent use occurs on site.

The facility conducts roto-mold or roto-cast plastic parts. There are six emission units all with ovens that roto-mold one of three densities of polyethylene plastic parts. The ovens are heated up to 800F and the part "bakes" for 15 minutes prior to cool down. The molds are specially made Teflon coated units that do not require the use of a mold release agent.

There are three silos which contain the three densities of polyethylene powder. A plastic grinder is utilizes and is internally vented with air socks for control. Also utilized is a soda blaster, which is also internally vented.

It appears as though this equipment falls under the Rule 286(a) exemption. Mr. Diekema provided natural gas usage records and AQD staff did a quick calculation on greenhouse gas emissions, and they appear to be well below the criteria. A true Potential To Emit demonstration is not necessary at this time.

The facility was in compliance at the time of the inspection.
