VIOLATION NOTICE

On July 1, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), verified crushing activities from a second crusher by Techni-Comp Environmental located at Parcel ID # 310-220-003-015-00, Crosswell, Michigan. The purpose of the follow up activities were to verify compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and a telephone call with company staff where it was determined the correct location of the second crusher.

Staff determined the following:

Crusher	Rule 201	Operating without a permit to install

A Violation Notice, dated July 1, 2021, was issued to Techni-Comp Environmental for operating a crusher on Parcel ID # 310-220-003-015-00 in Crosswell, Michigan without a permit to install. In a follow up call with staff, it was determined that a second crusher that is owned by Techni-Comp Environmental is also located on Parcel ID # 310-220-003-015-00. The second crusher had been previously determined to not be in operation with a permit and had appeared to have been located on the Port Huron, Michigan facility site. The AQD staff advised Techni-Comp Environmental that this is a violation of Rule 201 of the administrative rules promulgated under Act 451.

A program for compliance may include a completed PTI application for the crusher process equipment. An application form is available by request, or at the following website: www.michigan.gov/air (in the shaded box on the upper right-hand side of the page).

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by August 6, 2021 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.


As part of the response, Techni-Comp Environmental needs to provide the date of manufacturer and the max rated input capacity for the unpermitted crusher.

Please submit the written response to EGLE, AQD, Bay City District, at 401 Ketchum Street, Suite B, Bay City, Michigan 48708 and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If Techni-Comp Environmental believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
