Material including Category I and Category II nonfriable ACM must be removed in accordance with the NESHAP before burning. Mr. Jennings and the Venice Township Fire Department failed dictates that; if a facility is demolished by intentional burning, all Regulated Asbestos Containing materials prior to the intentional burn activities to have a thorough survey done on the property and failed to remove all asbestos containing remained along with asbestos containing siding material.
