VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 9, 2022, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) performed an inspection at 9444 West Saginaw Road, Reese, Tuscola County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my inspection, Saint Michael's Lutheran Church owned the former hall/storage facility. The facility was demoed by a parishioner of the church. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the *owner and operator* liable for all violations.

During the investigation, EGLE staff observed the following:

The Church's hall/storage facility was demolished, and the building debris was removed. The owner failed to submit the 10-working day Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish to the administrator prior to the demolition activities.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by June 1, 2022 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the date(s) the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the date(s) by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. The *signed* written response from the *owner and operator* to this violation notice, may be submitted by mail and directed to my attention at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. You must also include a copy to Jason Wolf, Enforcement Unit at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. The response may be scanned and emailed to DechyC@Michigan.gov and WolfJ2@Michigan.gov.

If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
