VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 9, 2018, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the residential property located at 12746 Terry, Detroit. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Den-Man Contractors, Inc.'s, the Detroit Land Bank Authority's, and the Detroit Building Authority's compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, the Detroit Land Bank Authority owns the facility and Den-Man Contractors, Inc. performed the demolition activities at the facility. The Detroit Building Authority oversees the City of Detroit's demolition programs. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds the owner and operators liable for violations.

DEQ AQD staff conducted an inspection of the site and noted dry plaster debris in the soil post-demolition. The asbestos plaster could not be safely removed prior to demolition due to structural issues.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by September 26, 2018 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If the Detroit Land Bank Authority, the Detroit Building Authority, and/or Den-Man Contractors, Inc. believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide factual information to explain your position.
