VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 16, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection of the following PAV properties located in Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan:

- 12074 Indiana Street (U821905981);
- 12078 Cherrylawn Street (U821906058).

The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451) and the consent judgement #18-862.

According to our investigation, MWV Environmental Services was the general contractor for the abatement activities and the Detroit Land Bank Authority owns the properties. The Detroit Building Authority oversees the City of Detroit's demolition programs. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the *owner and operator* liable for all violations.

The EGLE staff conducted an inspection of the sites and found Regulated Asbestos Containing Material (RACM) on air duct, Transite pieces (on the exterior of the home and garage) that were made RACM due to the removal methods and plaster. The subject structures were abated and had passed the PAV inspection.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by September 9, 2019 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the date(s) the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the date(s) by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. The *signed* written response from the *owner and operator* to this Violation Notice, may be submitted by mail and directed to my attention at: EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. You must also include a copy to Mr. Jason Wolf, Enforcement Unit at: EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
