SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On November 4, 2019, the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos inspection at 19100 West Seven Mile Road, Detroit, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

On November 25, 2019, the AQD sent a Violation Notice (VN) citing violations discovered because of the inspection and requested a written response by December 16, 2019. A copy of this VN has been enclosed for your reference. As of the date of this letter, the AQD has not received the written response to the cited violations.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions taken to resolve the cited violations may result in an escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in the VN dated November 25, 2019, by January 2, 2019, which corresponds to 15 days from the date of this letter.

The written response must be submitted to Mr. Jeffery Benya at EGLE, AQD, 3058 West Grand Boulevard, Suite 2-300, Detroit, Michigan 48202, and must include a copy to Mr. Jason Wolf, Enforcement Unit at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing,

VIOLATION NOTICE

On November 4, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Regency Heights Nursing Home located at 19100 West Seven Mile Road, Detroit, MI 48219. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, Ciena Healthcare Management, Inc. owns the facility and V-3 Industries, Inc. performed the demolition activities at the facility. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Demolition activities had disturbed suspect regulated asbestos containing (RACM). Upon sampling, the material tested positive for asbestos. The material, textured plaster ceiling was in a damaged, friable state and mixed in with general demolition debris.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by December 16, 2019 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
