VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 26, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the property located at 5409 Vancouver, Detroit. The purpose of the inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, the property is owned by the Detroit Land Bank Authority and the demolition activities were conducted by Detroit Next LLC beginning on February 17, 2020. The Detroit Building Authority manages the demolition program for the City of Detroit. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the owner and operators liable for all violations.

During the inspection, AQD staff noted that a notice of intent to renovate/demolish was not submitted for the above residential property prior to demolition. A notification should have been submitted to the AQD as soon as possible prior to beginning demolition activities.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by April 10, 2020 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
