VIOLATION NOTICE

SRN/ID: U822002387; Wayne County

On July 13, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 2226 Inkster Road and 2228 Inkster Road, Inkster, Wayne County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my investigation, Mr. Uchenna Ndubuisi owns the subject property and Essou Remodeling and Construction, LLC performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operators* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject facilities were in a state of partial demolition with an excavator on-site. A 10 day notification of intent to demolish was not submitted for this project.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this violation notice by August 11, 2020, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
