VIOLATION NOTICE

On December 16, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the commercial property located at 141 E. Great Lakes Avenue, River Rouge. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, the City of River Rouge owns the property and Richard Brown Contracting LLC performed the demolition activities at the property. United States Steel Corporation is overseeing the project. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds the owner and operators equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, AQD staff observed the following: Demolition of the building at 141 E. Great Lakes Avenue continued after the Notification of Intent to Demolish had expired on December 1, 2021.

The response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
