Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install (PTI) Application No. 13-19B submitted by FCA US LLC, to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), requesting changes to a previously permitted project involving a new automotive paint shop and proposed changes to the existing automotive assembly line at the Warren Truck Assembly Plant (Warren Truck), located at 21500 Mound Road in Warren, Michigan.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, EGLE held a public comment period that ended on June 14, 2021, with a public hearing on June 2, 2021, on its proposed conditional approval of the permit. The Air Quality Division (AQD) received no written comments during the public comment period and four verbal comments were presented at the public hearing and through voicemail.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of EGLE, I have approved PTI No. 13-19B with no modifications made to the proposed permit.
