Dear Ms. Nutini:

This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) applications, identified as Nos. 50-06D, State Registration Number N7581, and 405-08B, State Registration Number N0934. PTI application No. 50-06D is for changes to the surface operations and the timeframe of the ore truck throughput limit at the underground nickel and copper mine located at 6510 AAA Road, Michigamme Township, Michigan. PTI application No. 405-08B is for a change to the timeframe of the ore truck throughput limit at the nickel and copper processing mill located at 4547 County Road 601, Champion, Michigan.

The public comment period ended on April 3, 2020, and a virtual public hearing was held on March 30, 2020. Comments were received during the comment period and at the virtual public hearing.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI Nos. 50-06D and 405-08B. As part of this approval, Air Quality Division (AQD) staff has revised conditions to the PTIs to address certain information received during the public participation process and the subsequent analysis of that information.

The AQD has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments Document (RTC), which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the virtual public hearing. It also identifies the special conditions that have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. These changes are listed in Section II of the RTC.

The approvals are based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of EGLE and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplements. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

Also, PTI Nos. 50-06B and 405-08A have been voided because the equipment is now covered by PTI Nos. 50-06D and 405-08B, respectively.
