Dear Donna Dordeski:

This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application, identified as No. APP-2022-0192, for installation of a new sewage sludge disposal process to be located at 32360 Warkop Avenue in Warren, Michigan (State Registration Number B1792).

The public comment period ended on August 20, 2024, and a virtual public hearing was held on August 8, 2024. Comments were received during the comment period. After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 112-24. As part of this approval, Air Quality Division (AQD) staff has revised conditions to the permit to address certain information received during the public participation process and the subsequent analysis of that information.

The AQD has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments (RTC) Document, which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period. It also identifies the special conditions that have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. These changes are listed in Section II of the RTC Document. The RTC Document and the Permit Terms and Conditions are also available at Michigan.gov/EGLEAirPublicNotice, choose "[Final Decisions](#)."

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of EGLE and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required before commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Grand Rapids District Office at the address provided in the M-001 form instructions. Also, you must notify the Warren District Office, in writing, within 30 days after completion of the

installation, construction, reconstruction, relocation, or modification of the process or process equipment covered by this PTI.
