General Permit to Install for Portable Hot Mix Asphalt Plant

EGLE is holding a public comment period regarding a proposed General Permit to Install (general PTI) for a portable hot mix asphalt (HMA) plant from **August 20** until **September 28, 2026**.

The proposed general PTI is to allow the installation, operation, and relocation of a portable HMA plant.

General Permit to Install for Crematory Units

EGLE is holding a public comment period regarding a proposed General Permit to Install (general PTI) for crematory units from **August 20** until **September 28, 2026**.

The proposed general PTI is to allow the installation and operation of a maximum of three crematory units at the same facility that does not have any existing crematory units.
