I met with Tom Haines of Avon Automotive and Jeff Simsa and Adam Segerlind of Gosling-Czubak. We discussed the installation of the control equipment for the small ingredients area which I had previously discussed with the company. Avon is now moving forward with this project which will include the installation of dust collection on the portable carts used to mix ingredients and overhead dust collection on the bin storage area where raw materials are transferred into the bins.

The dust collectors will vent back inside the plant general atmosphere and as such, will meet the Rule 285(f) exemption. Should the need arise to vent the collectors outside additional review would be necessary to determine if this could be done under Rule 290 or if a PTI would be required due several toxic air contaminants that may not meet screening levels. ^{to}

Jeff Simsa also mentioned that the ROP renewal window would be opening next year and they plan to get the required stack testing completed prior to that, probably this fall. The renewal will require the incorporation of Boiler MACT requirements. Mr. Simsa was aware of the Boiler Mact assistance information available on the AQD website.
