Dear Ms. Zhu:

This letter follows up on FCA's December 21, 2021 Supplemental Response to AQDs November 1, 2021 Violation Notice. As you know, the VN alleged a violation of EU-PRIMERWEST, Special Condition IV.1 of Permit to Install No 13-19B for the failure to duct emissions from EUPRIMERWEST ambient flash zone to the regenerative thermal oxidizer control ("RTO").

FCA is pleased to notify you that the ducting to connect the unabated ambient flash zone to the existing concentrator and RTO was completed and made operational on February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022. As a result, the RTO now controls the ambient flash zone emissions as indicated in FCA's air permit.
