SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On June 23, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Mai Kai Cleaners located at 24235 West 7 Mile Rd. Detroit, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Mai Kai Cleaners compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

Specifically, this dry cleaner is subject to the federal National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities, Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 63, Subpart M and the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended, Dry Cleaning Establishment Rules Utilizing Class I, II, III, and IV Solvents.

On August 3, 2016, the AQD sent the company a Violation Notice citing violation discovered as a result of the inspection and requested your written response by August 24, 2016. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. As of this date, we have not received your response.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions the company will take or has taken to resolve the cited violations, may result in escalated enforcement actions by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in our August 3, 2016 letter by October 31, 2016, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violations Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.

VIOLATION NOTICE

On June 23, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division conducted an inspection of Mai Kai Cleaners located at 24235 West 7 Mile Road in Detroit. Specifically, this dry cleaner is subject to the federal National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities, Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 63, Subpart M and the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended, Dry Cleaning Establishment Rules Utilizing Class I, II, III, and IV Solvents.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:


Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by August 24, 2016, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
