VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 13, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), issued Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) No. MI-ROP-N1395-2014 to Cadillac Renewable Energy (CRE) located at 1525 Miltner Street in Cadillac, Michigan. Rule 213(3)(c)(i) of Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451), requires a permittee to submit a report at least once every six months of any required monitoring and all instances of deviations from permit requirements.

At this time, the DEQ has not received CRE's 2nd Semi-Annual and Annual Certification report for the year 2014, which was due March 15, 2015. This constitutes a violation of Special Conditions VII.2 and VII.3 under Reporting for EUBLR of ROP No. MI-ROP-N1395-2014 and Rule 213(3)(c)(i) of Act 451.

Please submit the reports within (21) days from the date of this letter. Each report must contain a certification by the Responsible Official that the statements and information in the report are true, accurate and complete.

If CRE believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
