INSPECTION: I met Mr. Troy Edwards upon arriving at the facility. Mr. Edwards and I went over the operation of the waste oil furnace in use in the maintenance garage. The facility burns only used oil generated onsite and are exempt from requiring a permit. They do not accept waste oil from the public. Additional heat is supplied by an outdoor wood-fired boiler and in-floor radiant heat in the shop.

The facility no longer utilizes a cold parts cleaner—it was removed in 2013.

Fugitive dust continues to be controlled by water application on an as-needed basis.

After I completed my district inspection for the associated PTI, Mr. Edwards provided records regarding the handling, acceptance, and disposal of asbestos waste containing materials. All waste manifest records were intact and detailed and locations of asbestos wasted within the landfill were recorded via GPS.

SUMMARY: I observed no violations of the state air pollution control rules or asbestos NESHAP during my inspection.

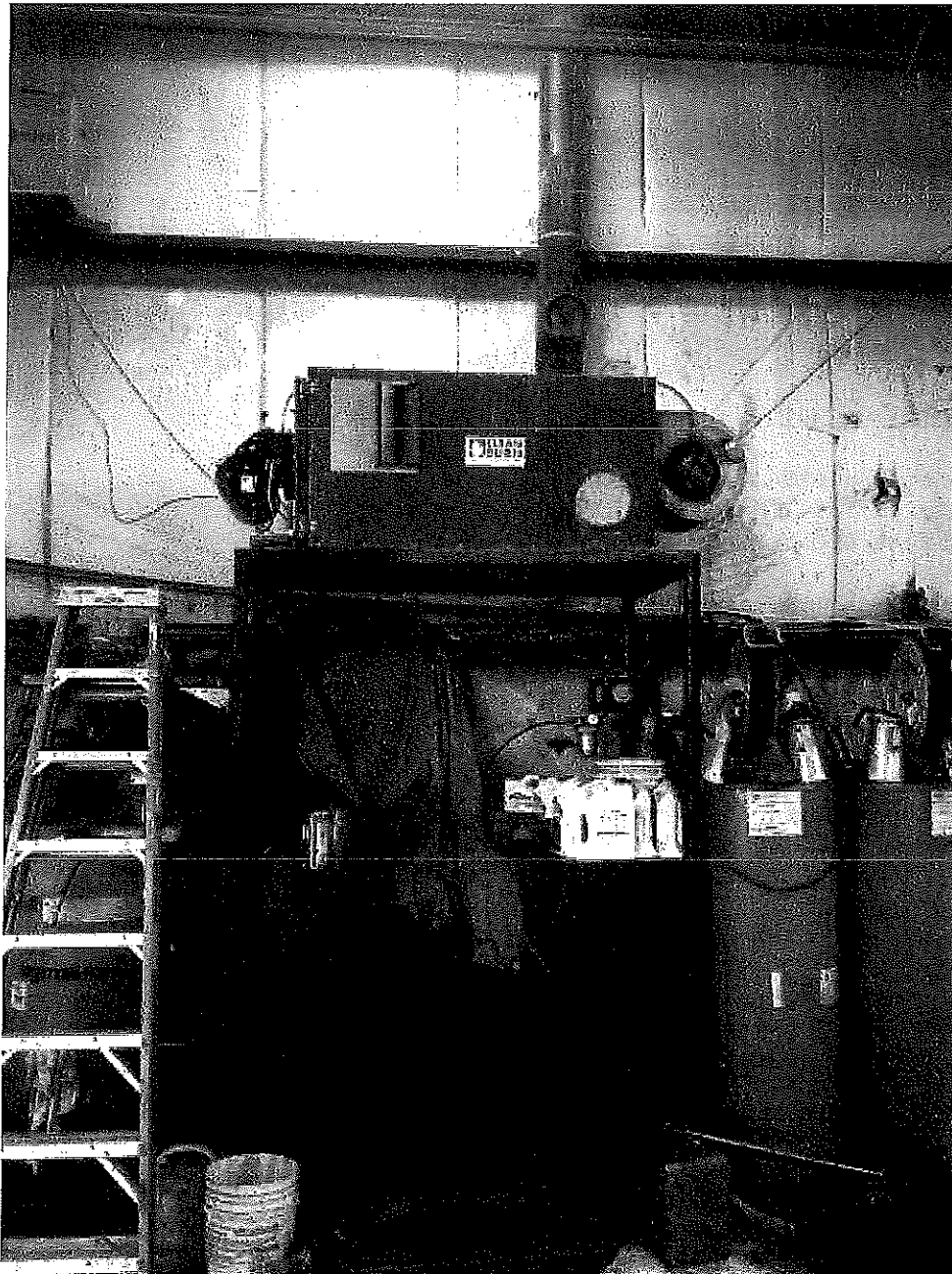


Image 1(WI1) : Waste oil furnace in shop

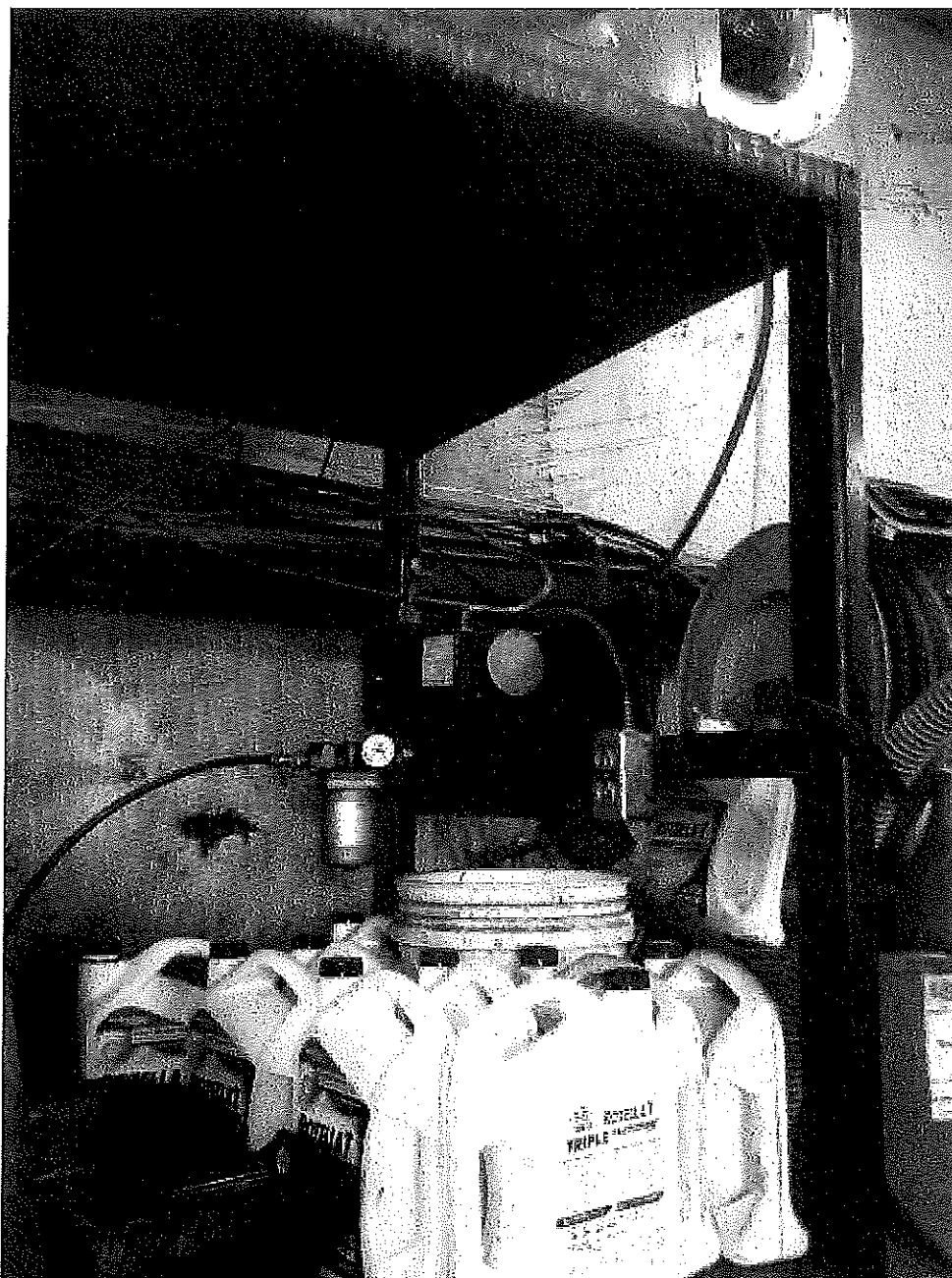


Image 2(WI2) : Tank & in-line filter supplying waste oil furnace in shop.
