Ms Koster,

We have received and reviewed the Violation Notice dated July 20, 2017. We have missed two reporting periods (January 2016-June 2016 and July 2016-December 2016) due to a termination of the employee who was to complete the reports. I have since took on this role and will be submitting the reports to you on time. We now suspect that the issue is fully resolved and do not expect to miss any of our reporting due dates. We have always maintained the proper records but have failed to provide the reporting of these. I am aware of the due dates for the reporting periods and have already set several reminders to complete our excess emissions report as I verify our records. As you are aware, we have submitted the outstanding excess emissions reports for the missed reporting periods on July 7, 2017.

No excess emissions occurred during any of the above-mentioned reporting periods. During each startup and shutdown, no flux and no feed/charge were added to the emission unit, and electricity, propane or natural gas were used as the sole source of heat or the emission unit was not heated.

Please advise of our findings, should they require more content.
