<b>SUBJECT:</b> The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a self-initiated inspection and to determine compliance status with respect to all applicable Air Quality Rules and Regulations.

This was an unannounced inspection. A copy of the "Environmental Inspections: Rights and Responsibilities" was supplied.

The purpose of this inspection was to conduct a self-initiated inspection and to determine compliance status with respect to all applicable Air Quality Rules and Regulations. The facility does not currently have any Air Quality permits, but does utilize some Rule 201 permitting exemptions.

JD arrived in the area of the facility at 1:55PM and left at approximately 2:45PM on February 12, 2014. No excess odors or opacity were observed during the inspection time. Mr. Jason Tuttle, Purchasing/Customer Service/Sales, provided pertinent information regarding the facility and the operations contained therein.

Dodds is a manufacturing and engineering company that creates other industrial machines that are utilized for wood-working, primarily for cabinet makers and dovetailing.


The primary operations at the facility consist of machining of metal. The equipment used in these processes are exempt from any Rule 201 permitting requirement under Rule 285(i)(vi)(B).

Dodds also has two welding stations that are exempt from Rule 201 permitting requirements under Rule 285(i).

The one small parts cleaner utilized is exempt from Rule 201 permitting requirements under Rule 281(h). This is a small parts cleaner maintained by an outside company. JD discussed with Mr. Tuttle the obligation to keep the cleaner closed when not in use and provided the "Cold Cleaner Operating Procedures" sticker.

In the past Dodds did their own coating, but now all of the parts that need to be coated are sent out for powder coating. The booth is still installed and can be operated if needed. Because the booth is used so infrequently, it is exempt from Rule 201 permitting requirements under Rule 287(c). Mr. Tuttle will track when and if the booth is used in the future in order to comply with the requirements of the exemption.

Based on observations made at the time of the inspection Dodds appears to be correctly utilizing Rule 201 exemptions and is in compliance with all applicable Air Quality rules and regulations. No further action is necessary at this time.
