VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 7, 2024, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection post planned renovation at 818 Riverside Avenue, Adrian, Lenawee County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my investigation, ProMedica, owns the facility and Midwest Environmental, Inc., performed the abatement activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) may hold both the *owner and operator* liable for all violations.

During the inspection, EGLE staff observed the following:

The facility was not demoed and abatement had occurred. However, asbestos containing Thermal Systems Insulation (TSI) was observed on two sections of straight pipe in the facility's basement. The contractor failed to remove this insulation during their scheduled abatement activities.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this violation notice by November 8, 2024. The written response should

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include: the date(s) the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the date(s) by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. The *signed* written response to this violation notice may be submitted by mail and directed to Jeremy Howe at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760. You must also include a copy to Jason Wolf, Enforcement Unit at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.
